### Treasurers Report & General Financial Details:

- Balance in main account as of 07-Jan-15 is €10,682.71, includes all expenditure to date. The balance of the social account is €390.61. The balance of the petty cash account is currently €38.40.
- WM reported that €60.00 had been collected since the last meeting. The total collection for this year is €11,610.
- The outgoings for December was €57 for printing. Petty cash expenditure for month was €37.60 for postage stamps, and €10 for travelling expenses to Galway to attend a Co.Co. meeting.
- WM reported that the collections for our fourth financial year had started well, as we are ahead of this time last year. Many thanks to all who have made their contributions.
- MG apologised to the meeting for spending an additional €105 described in this item in the last minutes, on additional shrubs and mulch in the front shrubbery without prior approval of the meeting. MG said it would not happen again.
- WM reported that annual/dividends had been paid to the Association by St.Jarleths Credit Union. This was €38.10 new with €26.47 being taken in DIRT tax.
- WM reported that a cheque for €60 had been returned unpaid. This was been addressed with the resident concerned.
